2025 VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES SCHEDULE

The Bambara Primary School Board has endorsed the Contributions and Charges Schedule for 2025 as per the School Education Act (1999) and School Education Regulations (2000). The information below and over the page will enable you to calculate the maximum costs you may incur during the 2025 school year.

Voluntary Contributions to the School

To assist us in providing your child with the best education we can offer, you are asked to pay \$60.00 per child. This payment along with other funding sources, enables us to maximise our learning programs.

Contributions can be paid directly to the school through the front office by **CASH or EFTPOS, DIRECT DEPOSIT** into the school's bank account or through **Campion** when ordering your child's personal requirements/ booklist online. Contributions collected by **Campion** are forwarded to the school.

The table below gives you a breakdown of where your 2025 contribution will be allocated.

Voluntary Contribution to the Parents and Citizens Association (P&C)

The P&C requests a voluntary contribution of \$40.00 per child to supplement their fundraising. This can be paid directly to the school as outlined above or through **Campion** when ordering your child's personal requirements/ booklist.

In 2024, the P&C has paid for the following:

- 12-month family subscription to Reading Eggs \$2,580.00, Mathseeds \$1,870.00 and Mathletics \$750.00 (total value \$5,200)
- Gymbus for 2024 welcome picnic \$560.00
- Donation towards 2024 leavers shirts \$220.00 (\$10 per student)
- Fun events for families and students that are not for fundraising purposes.

Personal Requirements – Booklists

For 2025, **Campion** has been awarded the contract to supply the personal requirements/ booklist. While the school receives a commission on total sales through Campion, you have the option of purchasing personal stationery items from a company of your choice. **Where possible to reduce costs, we encourage you to re-use items from the previous school year.**

In order that the correct edition of workbooks is purchased, it is recommended that the **Oxford Maths** and **Writing Time workbooks are purchased through Campion**.

Optional Costs

The schedule over the page provides a breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in excursions, incursions, and activities. You will only need to pay these costs when the student is involved in a particular activity. Student participation is conditional on payment and permission forms being received by the school by the due date.

The schedule includes costs associated with:

- > Specific learning activities available to all students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. incursions, excursions
- Specific learning activities available to selected students, but conditional on a payment being made e.g. PEAC, instrumental music program

Payment details

Payment of the school and P&C voluntary contributions (total of \$100.00 per child) are requested by 28 February 2025 with other costs billed to students accounts as they arise. In the event of families experiencing financial hardship, payment arrangements may be made by contacting the front office. Unpaid Billing Reminders will be sent out during the year. All payments are collected through the front office or direct bank deposit to the school's bank account.

The staff at Bambara Primary School look forward to continuing to work with you to provide our students with rich learning programs in 2025.
