## School Uniform Policy

## RATIONALE

The school uniform plays an important role in supporting the school’s values, promoting a positive school image, and fostering a strong sense of identity and belonging among students. It encourages equity, enhances school and team spirit, supports student safety, and instils a sense of pride while enabling students to be easily recognised within the local community. The school uniform has been developed in consultation with the School Board and the wider school community.

## GUIDELINES

Parents, staff and students support the School’s Dress Code. Enrolment at the school is on the understanding that the School’s Dress Code will be adhered to. Students on excursions must be in uniform unless the principal has granted consent. The Dress Code is enforced for all students, Kindergarten to Year 6.

## FOOTWEAR

Students are required to wear sensible, closed-in footwear and short plain socks or approved sandals to school. Thongs, ‘Ugg’ boots and slides are NOT considered to be appropriate footwear. Should a student’s medical condition necessitate the wearing of any of these items, then a written note must be provided by the Parent/Caregiver.

## HATS

As a ‘Sunsmart’ school, our vision is to ensure all students can work and play in UV-protective environments. Students must wear broad-brimmed/bucket hats when outside. Students who do not wear a hat will be asked to play in the undercover area. Please support this policy in the interests of your child’s long-term health. Hats may be purchased through the Uniform Shop.

## HAIR

All students must ensure that their hair does not create a safety or health risk. We recommend that long hair be tied back as a preventive measure to avoid or contain the spread of head lice. Hair extensions and brightly coloured hair are not recommended.
